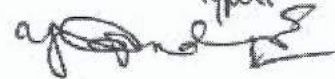

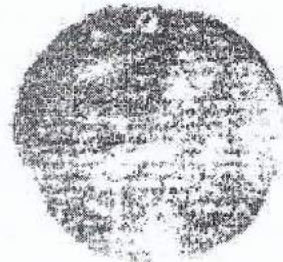

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF MARANATHA VISVASA SAMAJAM

1. Name: Maranatha Visvasa Samajam.
2. Location: At present 64-2-30, Patamatalanka, Vijayawada-14 or at any place in Krishna District to be decided by the Executive Committee of the Society.
3. The articles of Faith and Practices (Declaration of Faith): we believe: I. In the verbal inspiration of the Bible which is infallible and authoritative word of God. II. In one God eternally existing in three persons namely the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. III. In the deity of Jesus Christ, his conception of the Holy spirit, virgin birth, holy life, and that he died upon the Cross as the substitutionary sacrifice for the sins of the world and arose from the dead and ascended into heaven from where he will return with power and glory. IV. That all are sinners and that the forgiveness of sins and justification are wrought by repentance of sins and faith in Jesus Christ. V. In water Baptism by immersion. VI. In the holiness to be God's standard of living for his people, and that true devotion (piety) which God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world. VII. In the baptism of the Holy spirit with noticeable signs. VIII. In miraculous divine healing and the Lord's communion meal. IX. In the second coming of Jesus Christ, First, to resurrect the righteous dead and to catch away the living saints to him in the air. Second, to reign with the saints in the earth for a thousand years.

X. In bodily resurrection - eternal life for the righteous, and eternal damnation for the unrighteous.

4. Interpretations:- In these rules unless the context requires a different interpretation the words used shall have the following meaning. I. Society wherever mentioned means Maranatha Visvasa Samajam. II. The objects means the objects of the society as set forth in the memorandum 3 above. III. The Executive Committee means the Governing Body as elected in accordance with these rules. IV. Elders means those who are elected from the Faith centres. ----G.Moses Choudary, President-----Contd....5.

V. A member means a member admitted to the society as defined in rules 5 to 9. VI. Ordained minister is the one who has received ordination in the society. VII. The General council is comprised of all ministers and elders from the faith centers. VIII. A minister means a pastor or an Evangelist or a Colporteur or any other staff member appointed by the Executive Committee and who is fully engaged in the work of society. XI. The year and financial year means the period beginning on January 1 of any year and ending the last day of December of the same year.

MEMBERSHIP:

5. Membership of the society is granted to individuals who subscribe to the faith and practices of the society.

6. Procedure for granting membership:- The Executive Committee may accept a person into the membership on the recommendation of an ordained minister in the society.

7. Any member failing to uphold the objects of faith and practices of the society may be dismissed on the decision of the Executive Committee by majority vote of the Executive Committee present at the meeting.

8. Any member may resign from membership by giving one month's notice in writing and shall take effect upon acceptance by the Executive Committee without any prejudice.

9. On termination of membership a member shall forthwith cease to have any right or claim whatsoever to any rights or privileges of membership or to any property of the society and in particular to any refund of any subscription or other charges or dues paid by him to the society.

10. A faith center may be formed in a place where 10 members of society live and approved by Executive Committee. Each faith centre, which is approved by the Executive Committee and affiliated to the society, should have two or more elders elected triennially in the year of election of Executive Committee.

THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

11. The management of the society shall vest in the following office bearers: President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and three Executive Members.-----

12. The term of office of the Executive Committee shall be three years and all members of the Executive Committee shall be eligible for reelection.

13. If any member of the Executive Committee shall die, resign, become incapable or shall refuse to act or be absent from three consecutive meetings of the Executive Committee without reasonable cause or leave of absence his/her place on the Executive Committee shall be declared vacant and the Executive Committee may co-opt another person in his/her place who shall be a member of the Executive Committee for the unexpired portion or the period of office.

FUNCTIONS, POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

14. The Executive Committee shall control administer and manage the property, funds and affairs of the society.

15. The Executive Committee shall carry out, effect and perform the objects according to law and in accordance with these rules.

16. The Executive Committee shall appoint personnel and other employees whether honorary or otherwise and upon terms and conditions and at such remuneration as the Executive Committee shall think fit and from time to time shall remove and or replace such persons so appointed.

17. The Executive Committee shall appoint sub-committees as Executive Committee may from time to time deem expedient for carrying out of the objectives.

18. The Executive Committee is empowered to do the following in order to accomplish, acquire, further, finance, fulfill and promote all or any objectives of the Society: I. To run printing press for the purposes mentioned in Memorandum of Association 3, VI. II. To acquire, hold, lease, manage, transfer or dispose of property movable or immovable for the financing and/or furtherance of the stated objectives of the society. III. To accept and carry out any trusts attached to gifts or bequests to or for the benefit of the society. IV. To invest in any legal manner all or any monies held by the society on such trusts. V. To adopt legal means for the raising the soliciting of money and for obtaining property for the furtherance of the objects of the society and to accept contributions, collections, donations, gifts, grants and subsidies. VI. To raise monies for the furtherance of the objects of the society. VII. To draw, make accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue promissory notes, cheques, bills of exchange, warrants and other negotiable securities or transferable institutions-----G.Moses Choudary, President-----Contd...7.

VIII. To appoint and suspend, discharge and dismiss pastors / Evangelists / Colportures and other staff who voluntarily accept to assist in the work of the society; and to obtain professional and other advice and services. IX. To average the ministers live and work by faith in God who supplies the needs because the ministries of Maranatha Visvasa Samajam are operated by faith in God and to given partial financial assistance as the funds of the society may permit to do so.

OFFICERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

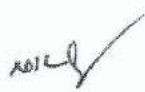
19. The following officers shall control, administer and manage the affairs of the society. I. The president shall be the head of the Executive Committee and shall exercise leadership of the work of the society. At every meeting the President shall preside over the meeting. II. In the event of the absence of the President the Vice-President shall discharge the duties of the President. III. The Secretary whose duties shall be to give notices of all meetings, to keep minutes and records of all meetings of the society and of any Committees and to perform such other duties as the Executive Committee may direct and as are normally incidental to the office of a Secretary. The secretary may serve as treasurer also if the Executive Committee should so decide. IV. The Treasurer of the society shall have the custody of the books of account and charge of the funds of the society. V. The Executive Committee may point other persons as they consider necessary for specific duties, or to fill casual vacancies among the officers.

20. The General Council shall be summoned by the Executive Committee once in a year in the month of June in the manner here in after described. The business to be transacted at the Annual General Council Meeting shall be: I. To approve the minutes of the previous General Council and of any other General Council Meetings which may have been held since the date of the last Annual General Council Meetings. II. To receive from the Executive Committee a report and financial statement of accounts for the preceeding financial year duly audited. III. To elect members of the Executive Committee once in three years as provided by these rules. IV. To appoint a chartered accountant to audit the accounts of the society. V. To review and plan in outline the work of the society. -----G.Moses Choudary, President.-----Contd..8.

VI. To consider and decide any other matter which may properly be brought before the meeting through the Executive Committee.

21. Special General Council Meeting: It shall be summoned by the Secretary in consultation with the President to transact any urgent business.

22. Procedure for General Council Meeting: I. Notice for calling an annual General Council Meeting must be sent in writing to the ministers and Elders by the Secretary at least 15 days in advance of the date and place fixed for the meeting. Notice for calling a special General Council Meeting must be sent in writing to them by the Secretary at least 7 days in advance of the date and place fixed for the meeting. II. Quorum at Annual General Council Meeting shall be 1/3 of its membership present personally. III. Quorum for special General Council Meeting shall be one half of its membership. IV. Every minister and elder shall be entitled to attend General Council Meeting and shall have one vote each. V. In the case of an equality of votes the President of the meeting shall be entitled to a casting vote.

23. Executive Committee Meeting: I. The Executive Committee shall meet at least twice in a year and from time to time and in such places as is considered necessary. II. The President may from time to time convene a meeting of the Executive Committee in addition to the meetings prescribed above stating the purpose for which the meeting is required. III. Notice must be given by the Secretary in writing to each member at least 3 days prior to the date fixed for such meeting. IV. Quorum for Executive Committee shall be 4.

24. The Executive Committee shall cause proper books of accounts to be provided and true and accurate entries to be made there in of the assets and liabilities of the Society under the authority of these rules and regulations and in pursuance of the several objects of the Society.

25. All monies collected or raised belonging to the society shall come into the hands of the Treasurer and be paid into a current account in the name of the Society at such scheduled bank as the Executive Committee shall decide.

26. No money may be withdrawn from the said bank account except by the Cheque signed jointly by the President and Treasurer or by the President and one person appointed by the Executive Committee. -----G.Moses Choudary, President.-----Contd..9.

27. Immediately after the end of each financial year the Treasurer shall cause the accounts audited and place the same for consideration by the Executive Committee and for approval by the General Council Meeting.

Application of Funds and Property:

28. The income from all or any aspects of the society's activities can be used in furtherance of all or any of the objects of the society.

29. All or any monies or property given, donated, devised or bequeathed to the society of the objects may be expended for or applied towards that purpose.

30. Amendment to the Memorandum of Association of Society: This memorandum of association may be altered, added to or otherwise ammended by a resolution duly passed by a majority of 3/5 of the members of General Council present and entitled to vote at a Special General Council Meeting convened for that purpose provided that the notice for convening such a meeting whether annual or otherwise shall set forth the purport of such alteration, additions, rescisions, or to other amendments, and that such notice be given 15 days previous to the Special General Council Meeting. A second Special General Council Meeting must confirm such resolutions and shall be held at aninterval of one month after the former meeting.

31. Copies in duplicate of every such alteration, addition, rescision or amendment shall forth with be delivered to the Registrar of Societies to be filled with the memorandum of association and rules and Regulations of the Society.

32. The society can sue or be sued in the name of the President of the society or the person that the Executive Committee may decide.

The Dissolution: No resolution for dissolving the society shall be taken effect unless it shall have been consented to by a majority vote of the members of the General Council Meeting convened for the purpose and unless in the notice summoning such meeting due notice shall have been given of the intention to move such a resolution to dissolve the society be passed by a majority of the members of the General Council.

34. Upon dissolution of the society its assets will be handed over to a Registered society with similar objects after clearing all its debts and liabilities. -----G.Moses Choudary, President.-----Contd..10.

1. Amendments to the Rules and Regulations of Association:
 - a. Amendment to Clauses No.30 & 34:

Existing Clause No.30

This Memorandum of Association may be altered, added to, or otherwise amended by a resolution duly passed by a majority of 3/5 of the members present and entitled to vote at a Special General Council Meeting convened for that purpose provided that the notice for convening such a meeting whether annual or otherwise shall set forth the purport of such alteration, additions, rescissions or to other amendments, and that such notice be given 15 days previous to the Special General Council Meeting. A Second General Council Meeting must confirm such resolutions and shall be held at an interval of one month after the former meeting.

Added to Existing Clause.30

The Society formed under the above title is irrevocable.

That the Society will not carry out any alteration/ amendments/ modification to the deed/ memorandum of Association/ Rules and Regulations without the jurisdiction of the Commissioner of Income Tax having jurisdiction over the case.

Existing Clause No.34

Upon dissolution of the Society its assets will be handed over to a Registered Society with similar objectives after clearing all its debts and liabilities.

New Clause to be substituted.

That in the event of dissolution, the assets still remaining in the name of the Society after full satisfaction of all the liabilities of it will be handed over to some other Society/ organization having similar aims and objectives and having registered u/s. 12A and to which the provisions of section 80 G(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 do apply.

Resolved to add the following clauses in addition to the existing 34 Clauses of the Rules and Regulations of the Association as continuous serial number, Viz., 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40.

35. The investment of the funds of the Society will be in accordance with the provisions of the sections 13(1) (d) r.w.s.11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
36. The Society shall not carry its activities anywhere outside India.
37. The Society will maintain its accounts regularly and accounts will be audited by a qualified auditor every year.
38. The income of the Society will be solely utilized towards the objects/ and no portion of it will be used for payments to the trustees/ members by way of profit or by any other means.
39. The income of the Society will be for the benefit of all irrespective of caste, religion, colour, sex etc.,
40. The Society will not carry on any activity with the object of earning profit.

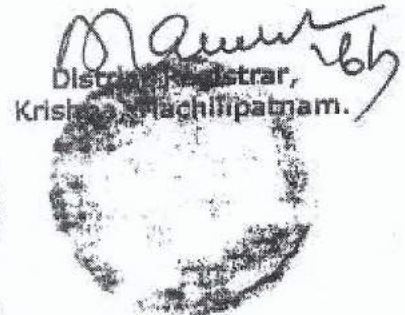
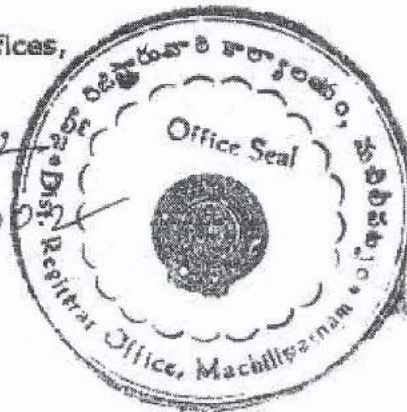
